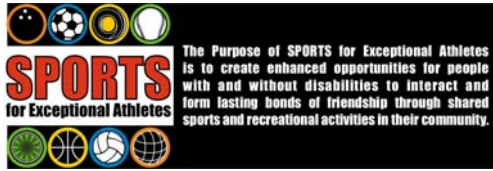

### Prize Categories

**Divisional "Cooking Medal" Awards:** The top 3 teams in each division, decided by popular vote, will remake their recipe for the official judges for the final rounds. Cooking medals will be presented to the top 3 teams in each division.

**"Guacamole Bowl" Trophy:** The gold medal winners from each of the divisions (Law Enforcement, Realtors, Open) will then compete for the highly coveted "Guacamole Bowl" Trophy.

**People's Choice Award:** The general public will have the opportunity to vote (one vote per person) for the recipe they deem the best across all divisions. The winner of the People's Choice Award will advance to the final round of their division.

**Best Decorated Table:** An award will be presented to the best decorated table, as judged by the general public.
